



# EAP: BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL



## **Emergency Personnel:**

- ATC will be on site for games and practice periodically during season.
- AED trained head coach on site.

## **Emergency Communication:**

- Cell phones will be the primary communication method.
- If a radio station is present they can be used as well.

## **Emergency Equipment:**

- In season practice – First Aid Kit, AED machine, Ice
- Off season practice – First Aid Kit
- Game – Athletic Training Kit if ATC is present, First Aid Kit, Ice, Biohazard Kit.
- Additional emergency equipment accessible from the Middle School and High School storage rooms.
- Additional AED available in the Middle School gym.

## **Roles of the First Responders: - ATC will be in charge of care if present:**

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
3. Activation of emergency medical system
  - a. Call 911 from land line or 773-3111 from cell phone & provide name, address, telephone number, number of individuals injured and their conditions, treatment administered, specific directions to complex and any other information requested.
  - b. Remain on the phone until directed by 911 personnel to end call.

## **Roles of the event supervisor:**

- Meet or “flag down” EMS and direct EMS personnel to the scene if ATC has called for their assistance.
  - Or designate someone to meet EMS personnel.
- Open doors and clear path for EMS personnel to enter and leave facility.
  - Or designate someone to open doors or clear a path.
- Scene control: limit the scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from the area.

## **Venue Directions:**

The baseball/softball complex is located at 505 E. Main St. Across from the FS gas station. Enter using the west entrance and proceed to the southwest corner of the parking lot.

## **Lightning:**

- Safe Shelter Location: Brown County Middle School gymnasium, Concession stand (when construction is complete), Cars
