Read 2 articles online or from a newspaper/magazine and create a quiz.	Write a letter to someone who means a lot to you.	Make a goods and services collage using newspapers and magazines.
Play teacher: read to someone for 20 minutes and stop and ask questions along the way.	Create an informational book on a topic of your choice.	Create a map of your room, your house, or anything you can imagine. Include a map key
